2023 marks BASOC's 38th Anniversary, so it is appropriate to take note of our history as we review the activities of this past year. We are very proud of our longstanding allegiance to the goals, tenets, values and aspirations of the Olympic Movement. We have remained true to our ultimate goal of hosting an Olympic Games by promoting amateur sports, youth fitness, lifetime wellness and major national and international sporting events. We have operated with integrity and transparency, with never a hint of financial or operational controversy. And we have much to look forward to.

The San Francisco Bay Area Sports Organizing Committee (BASOC) – founded in 1985 – is dedicated to advancing the goals and values of amateur sport and the Olympic Movement. BASOC does this by bidding for, delivering and managing major international and national sporting events for the San Francisco Bay Area.

BASOC partners with the Northern California Olympians and Paralympians Alumni Chapter (NCOPA) to promote Olympic ideals and Olympism. We look forward to working with Southern California Olympians to inspire youth during the 7-year run up to the 2028 LA Olympic & Paralympic Games.

BASOC depends on the support of individuals and corporations to fund BASOC's mission, with corporate, community and individual contributions and producing fundraising events such as the annual BASOC Celebrity Golf Classic, BASOC's Olympic Night at the San Francisco Giants and the *Welcome Home Olympians and Paralympians Dinner*, held each quadrennial to celebrate the achievements of the region's Olympians and Paralympians.

- BASOC continues to support International, National and Regional sporting events in the San Francisco Bay Area.
- BASOC continues outreach programs to share the ideals and values of Olympism with Bay Area youth in partnership with the Northern California Olympians and Paralympians Association especially on June 23rd World Olympic Day.
- BASOC supports the development of new sporting facilities and venues in the San Francisco Bay Area from world-class arenas to youth and community playing fields.

A non-profit 501 (c-3) organization (94-3052945), BASOC believes that the San Francisco Bay Area is an exceptional best place for sports and athletes. World-class facilities, enthusiastic audiences, a dynamic economy, beautiful scenery and a perfect climate allow the Bay Area to host preeminent sporting events and to offer ideal training conditions for athletes in every sport.

BASOC provided leadership, support and management for the 1994 World Cup, the 1999 Women's World Cup, the 2006 FINA World Masters Championships, the 2007 Junior World Table Tennis Championships, the 2008 United States Olympians and Paralympians Reunion, the 2009 Summer National Senior Games, the 2011 USA Swimming National and Junior National Championships, the 2014 Men's Foil Fencing World Cup, the annual Bay Area Senior Games, now in its 17th year, and created and produced the festivities for the 40th Anniversary of Ping Pong Diplomacy with United States and Chinese Olympians. BASOC hosted the 2016, 2018, 2021, 2022 Encore Games, the 2nd California State qualifier for the 2017, 2019, 2022 Summer National Senior Games.

In keeping with BASOC's mission, BASOC submitted Bids for the 1996, 2012, 2016 and 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games. With the IOC's choice of Los Angeles to be the site of the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games, BASOC is committed to support Los Angeles 2028, to help promote Olympic and Paralympic sports for all youth and ensure that the 2028 Games are the best ever Games for the Athletes. BASOC expects some venues and training sites to be in Northern California as they were in the very memorable 1984 Olympic Games.

BASOC supported the winning Bid for the FIFA 2026 World Cup to be held in the United States, Canada and Mexico and look forward to World Cup 2026.
